Teaching

Bluffton High School students receive a completer certificate after earning credits for courses offered in the well-established Health Sciences/Sports Medicine program. The courses currently offered by Bluffton High School in this program include Health Science 1, Health Science 2, Health Sciences 3, Sports Medicine 1, Sports Medicine 2, Sports Medicine 3, Work-Based Learning (internship), PLTW Principles of Biomedical Science and PLTW Human Body Systems. Courses will be assigned by the Principal.

Athletic Training

Bluffton High School and its sports medicine program was awarded and recognized as a NATA Safe Sports School. The Bobcats currently compete in South Carolina's Class AAAA.

The Assistant Athletic Trainer will assist the Head Athletic Trainer with all aspects of the administration and supervision of the sports medicine program and providing care to Bobcat student-athletes. Event and injury clinic responsibilities are assigned by the Head Athletic Trainer and/or Athletic Director.

Requirements:

Applicants must have a South Carolina Health Science Technology certification **OR** complete South Carolina's alternative teaching program that allows professionals to earn certification while teaching in Health Sciences. To be eligible for the alternative program, applicants must have at least 6 months of recent full-time employment experience as a Certified Athletic Trainer. Graduate assistantships and internships may fulfill this requirement. Candidates must have South Carolina Athletic Trainer Certification or eligible.
