At Palmetto Health-USC Orthopedics, formerly USC Sports Medicine, our residency program for certified athletic trainers is designed to help athletic trainers expand their knowledge and diagnosis skills in musculoskeletal evaluation. It is the mission of the Palmetto Health USC Orthopedic Athletic Training Residency Program is to provide a multifaceted learning experience in musculoskeletal evaluation, and diagnosis of Orthopaedic injuries in order to lead in a variety of clinical, surgical, and educational settings. We are one of seven programs in the country accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Athletic Training Education (CAATE).
