



Job Description:

Augusta University and the Medical College of Georgia Department of Orthopedics Surgery is seeking a Doctoral Level Athletic Trainer and innovative thinker to fulfill a unique position that will push the profession of Athletic Training forward. This person will work to establish a musculoskeletal curriculum for medical students and provide an immediate positive impact on the health of the community by coordinating sports medicine outreach opportunities for medical students at local high schools working alongside our athletic trainers. This person will also provide guidance and managerial support to a rapidly growing athletic training staff currently working in the high school, collegiate, and clinical settings.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience (The rank is “Instructor”)

Requirements:

The minimum requirements include completion of an accredited program in Athletic Training, completion of a Doctoral Program in Applied Health Sciences, Allied Health, Athletic Training, or equivalent.

NATA certification, GA license or eligible, CPR certification, and at least 5 years experience working as an Athletic Trainer.

Conditions of Employment:

All candidates are required to successfully pass a background check review. For specific positions, the final candidate may be subject to a (pre-employment) physical, drug screen, and/or credit check.

The final candidate will be required to provide proof of completed degree in the form of an original transcript. Those candidates trained by a foreign institution will also be required to provide an educational/credential evaluation.
